



Logistics Qualification System Program: LQSP PLUS Certified Logistics Professional Course 2019

The development of logistics systems in Thailand's industrial sector is important to the competitiveness of manufacturing and service sectors. Technology advances have played a role in developing and optimizing the processes of logistics system. Human recourse development is a key factor in logistics development. Japan is the model of successful logistics personnel development that strengthen the industrial and economic sectors of country.

Thai National Shippers' Council (TNSC) has been initially supported by the Japan Institute of Logistics System (JILS) and Japan External Trade Organization (JETRO) to set up the training program "Logistics Qualification System Program (LQSP)" for the middle level management since 2008 by incorporating the content and qualification system of Japan as a model with minor adaptation to suit the industrial environment in Thailand.

Later in 2016, TNSC cooperated with the College of Logistics and Supply Chain, Sripatum University to link the theory and practice more completely. In 2018, TNSC updated the content of Logistics Qualification System Program (LQSP) to be more modern and suitable for the current logistics and supply chain management and renamed the program to be "LQSP PLUS". Additionally, disruptive technology and related issues are added in this training program. Trainees will learn the benefits of using digital technology to support logistics activities and manage the logistics and supply chain in their companies more efficiently.
